- 2.1 The competition date and time of each level will be arranged based on the number of participants, the information will be confirmed after the Team Managers Meeting. The above schedule is for reference only.
- 2.2 Floor Exercise of Novice Level: The 14m x 1.5m mat will be set on the 12m x 12m FX mat.

- 3.3 Any individual events with less than 3 entries will be cancelled and refunds will be made accordingly.

### 4. Eligibility:

- 4.1 Each gymnast can participate in one level only. Gymnasts who participated in the previous Hong Kong Artistic Gymnastics Open & Novice Championships whether achieved top 3 result or not, can choose to promote to the next level or stay at the previous level this year, while must fulfill the age requirement of each level.
- 4.2 Except Squad B, all current gymnasts in Hong Kong Artistic Gymnastics Squad are applicable for participating in Elementary level or above.

4.4 Participants in Elementary and Novice level must be born on or after 1 January, 2005.

### 5. Enrollment Details:

- 5.1 Entry Fee: 1) \$120 for each gymnast in individual event categories;
  - 2) Add \$30 for insurance fee for each gymnast
- Please mail the application form with the copy of personal identification document and the cheque made payable to "The Gymnastics Association of Hong Kong, China" to the following address: Room 1002, Olympic House, 1 Stadium Path, So Kon Po, Causeway Bay, Hong Kong. Please write down the name of participant, contact number, competition level and "HK AG Open" at the back of the cheque.

  Any applications by fax, email and post-dated cheque are NOT accepted.

  Deadline: 7 February, 2022 (Mon). No late applications will be considered (Based on the arrival date to office).
- Please mail the Application Form for Coach Accreditation Card with photo before 7 February, 2022 (Mon) to our Association. No late or incomplete applications will be considered (Based on the arrival date to office).

### 6. Rules & Regulations:

- 6.1 For the details of routines, scoring schemes and apparatus please refer to our website www.gahk.org.hk.
- 6.2 The competitions will take place according to FIG Code of Points 2017~2020.
- 6.3 No appeals will be entertained for this competition after the Referees have confirmed a decision.
- 6.4 A competitor code and a competition numbered-bib will be distributed for each participant on competition day.
- 6.5 There will be a deduction of points for competitors not meeting the requirements according to FIG Code of Points 2017~2020.

### 7. Podium Training (Applicable for Open Level Only)

Podium Training will be held on 25 March 2022 (Fri) start from 17:00 (the exact period will be confirmed after the Team Managers Meeting). Gymnasts who participated in Open level and their coaches can attend the podium training during the captioned period with the valid athlete and coach accreditation card.

### 8. Scoring & Award:

- 8.1 The points scored in each individual event will be counted for the Individual All-Around.
- 8.2 Top 3 of all level in Individual All-Around and individual event will be awarded a medal and a certificate while top 4-8 will be awarded a "Certificate of Merit".
- 8.3 N-1 system will be applied in case the total enrollment does not reach the total number of awards to be presented.
- 8.4 Participants of Open Senior & Junior will be awarded if they achieve a score 6.00 or above.

### 9. Coach Accreditation Card:

- 9.1 Each gymnast can only apply for 1 coach to enter to the competition area
- 9.2 Applicants must be a valid Artistic Gymnastics Registered Coach of The Gymnastics Association of Hong Kong, China (GAHK)\*
- 9.3 All Coaches must wear the valid Coach Accreditation Card to enter the competition area. Non Coach Accreditation Card holders are not allowed to enter the competition area.

  Fill in the form in Appendix II and post to the our office with a recent photo before 7 February, 2022 (Mon). No late or incomplete applications will be considered.
- 9.5 Coach Accreditation Cards must be collected before the competition day, details of collection will be uploaded to our website on 7 March, 2022 (Mon)

#### 10. **Guardian Pass:**

In order to reduce crowds, each athlete can only have two guardians to apply for the "Guardian Pass" for entering the spectator aera, and must be complete the online application form before 7 February, 2022 (application link: <a href="https://forms.gle/mAnfyH3CQMKP6vjZ9">https://forms.gle/mAnfyH3CQMKP6vjZ9</a>). The "Guardian Pass" will be distributed during the registration on the competition day.

### 11. Team Managers Meeting:

The Team Managers Meeting will be held on <u>2 March</u>, <u>2022 (Wed) at 7:00pm</u> via online platform. Drawing of lots for competitors' order will be conducted and the competition information will be distributed. Participants can assign representative to attend the meeting. ### 12. Others:

- 12.1 Unless stipulated, all rules and regulations will follow The Gymnastics Association of Hong Kong, China.
- 12.2 According to our policy, all enrolled participants must pay for the insurance fee (i.e. Personal Accident Insurance) in addition to the entry fee for the event. Participants can purchase extra insurance due to specific needs. You may find more details on the insurance coverage in our website and read the Physical Activity Readiness attached in Appendix I.
- 12.3 If any participant(s) is/are found to be impostors, the Association will have the right to order him/her/them to withdraw from the competition and his/her/their result(s) in the competition will be cancelled. Enrolment fee will not be refunded.

- 12.4 The competition organizing committee will make corresponding arrangements according to the latest situation of the pandemic.
- 12.5 Athlete and Coach Accreditation Cards must be collected before the competition day, details of collection will be uploaded to our website on 7 March, 2022 (Mon).
- 12.6 <u>All Coaches must wear the valid Coach Accreditation Card to enter the competition zone.</u> No late or incomplete applications will be considered.
- 12.7 For the awardees, please collect the certificates at our office according to the email notification of the award collection after the competition, failure to do so constitute forfeiture.
- 12.8 Special Arrangement under the pandemic please refer to Appendix III
- 12.9 The Chinese version shall prevail

### **Physical Activity Readiness**

- 1. I certify that:
- My doctor has never said that I have a heart condition <u>and</u> that I should only do physical activity recommended by a doctor.
- I have never felt pain in my chest when I do physical activity.
- In the past month, I did not have had chest pain when I was not doing physical activity.
- I have never lost my balance because of dizziness or I have never lost consciousness.
- I do not have a bone or joint problem (for example, back, knee or hip) that could be made worse by a change in my physical activity.
- My doctor is not currently prescribing drugs (for example, water pills) for my blood pressure or heart condition.
- I do not know of any other reasons why I should not do physical activity.
- 2. It is suggested that you should determine your basic fitness so that you can have the best planning when doing physical activity. It is also highly recommended that you have your blood pressure evaluated and consult your doctor before you join the event.
- 3. If you are not feeling well because of a temporary illness such as cold or fever, please join the event after you feel better.
- 4. If you are or may be pregnant, please talk to your doctor before you join this event.
- 5. You should start the activity slowly and build up gradually. This is the safest and easiest way to go.
- 6. If you have the above health changes, tell your doctor or the coach. Ask whether you should continue this event.
- 7. If you know of any other reasons such as safety, disease, or condition changes that may influence you to join the event, you should notice the GAHK in writing.
- 8. If necessary, the GAHK has the right to request your medical certificate for reference.
- 9. If you have any questions of this physical activity readiness, please consult your doctor before you join the event.

### Special Arrangement under the COVID-19 Pandemic

### **Competition Arrangement**

- 1. Each person can participate in one level only. Gymnasts who participated in previous Hong Kong Artistic Gymnastics Open & Novice Championships whether achieved top 3 result or not, can choose to promote to the next level or stay at the previous level this year, while must fulfill the age requirement of each level.
- 2. Each athlete can only have two guardians to apply for the "Guardian Pass", and must be complete the electronic application form before 7 February, 2022 (application link: <a href="https://forms.gle/mAnfyH3CQMKP6viZ9">https://forms.gle/mAnfyH3CQMKP6viZ9</a>).
- 3. The competition organizing committee will make corresponding arrangements according to the latest situation of the COVID-19 pandemic.

### **Entering the Competition Venue**

- 1. In accordance with the government's latest anti-epidemic arrangements, all persons entering the office premises and venues of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department must use the "Travel with Peace" mobile application to scan the QR code of the premises. Under the new arrangement, people under the age of 12 and 65 or above and people with disabilities who have difficulty in using "Safe Travel" will be exempted from using "Safe Travel" when entering the office premises and venues of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. According to the actual situation, the department will also exempt individuals from using "travel with peace of mind" when entering office premises and venues. All exempted persons must fill out a form to register their name, the first four digits or letters of their identity documents, contact number, and the date and time of the visit, and must display relevant identity documents for verification during registration as required by the personnel of the relevant premises. The personnel of the relevant premises will also call to verify the contact number.
- 2. All persons must take their body temperature when entering the venue and the body temperature must be below 37.5 °C.
- 3. If participants' body temperature is 37.5°C or above, or have any symptoms of upper respiratory tract infection, sore throat, cough, muscle pain, fatigue, breathing difficulty, diarrhea, loss of smell or taste, they should stop participating in the activities and competitions, and seek medical advice promptly;
- 4. All persons entering the competition venue (including participants, coaches and officials) must fill in the health declaration form before the competition and submit it on the competition day, otherwise they will not be able to enter the competition venue;
- 5. Before entering the venue, all people must use hand sanitizer or soap to disinfect their hands.

### **During the Competition**

- 1. Arrangement for wearing a surgical mask (mask):
  - All participants including judges, coaches and staffs must wear a surgical mask (mask) at all time.
  - Gymnasts can choose whether to wear a surgical mask during warm-up exercises and competitions. If necessary to remove the mask, it should be stored properly. At other times, gymnasts must wear a mask.
- 2. Participants must abide by the venue regulations and COVID-19 prevention measures of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department. No more than four people a group, with a distance of at least 1.5 meters between each team.
- 3. In order to reduce crowds, there will be no award ceremony this year. The results of the competition will be uploaded to GAHK website. Each awardee will receive an email notification for more details of the award collection after the competition.
- 4. In order to reduce crowds, please leave the competition venue when each gymnast has finished their competition.
- 5. The association reserves the right to change the above special arrangements without further notice. In case of any dispute, the decision of the association will be final.
